	Graeme Scott welcomed Crispian Cook from Bell Ingram who was attending the meeting to brief the committee on the feasibility study and contribute to discussion.	
1	Minutes of meeting of 8 th June The minutes were approved by Steve Byford and seconded by John Graham.	
2	 Matters arising from the minutes → Company formation and bank account Mia Scott has e-mailed Douglas Graham at Macleod and MacCallum but had no reply. Mia to contact Douglas Graham again. Andrew Leaver has paperwork for opening a Treasurer's Account at Bank of Scotland. This will require signatories to go into the bank and show ID. Andrew to complete paperwork and lodge with bank. Graeme Scott, John Graham and Lara McDonald to go into bank with ID. The Highland Council have paid the Ward Discretionary Budget grant of £2650 to Kilmorack Hall Company. Graeme Scott will contact HIE CLU to request an up-front payment. Lara McDonald to ask Strathglass Community Woodland to hold their funds until the bank account is opened. 3	 Feasibility study including community consultation Crispian Cook provided a description of the community consultation process and the activity involved in the wider feasibility study. The content of the community survey has been agreed and will be posted to 317 households taken from the electoral roll. These should arrive on Wednesday 24th June. 	

•	A stakeholders list is being prepared and Andrew Leaver asked the committee to comment on this. Andrew to circulate stakeholders list again.	A Leaver
•	Patrick Laughlin of Bell Ingram will be analysing the results of the community survey and conducting interviews with key stakeholders, including committee members.	
•	Richard Till of Bell Ingram now has the FCS compartment information and is investigating the potential productivity of the forest based on this information. This will give an estimate of potential income from traditional management of the forest.	
•	Joe Fergusson of Bell Ingram will be investigating potential renewable energy related projects including wind farm, small scale hydro and wood chip.	
•	There was some discussion on the valuation process, with Crispian Cook highlighting that the commercial market value may be higher than the value indicated by the rate of return from traditional forestry management. This is because open market purchasers may have different reasons for buying the forest.	
•	Graeme Scott suggested that we may want to investigate a purchase which would leave the right to fell trees with either FCS or a private forestry company. This may decrease the purchase price of the land but would leave a reduced potential for on-going income. Crispian Cook to ensure this is included in the feasibility study.	C Cook
•	It was stressed that the forest will not be run as a commercial enterprise but as a social enterprise and that it is therefore important that Bell Ingram think outside normal parameters when developing the feasibility study and business plan. The committee needs to be presented with options for purchase of whole or part of the forest and with a wide range of different management options based on the 5 E's of Environment, Economy, Energy, Education and Enjoyment.

•	Crispian Cook offered to provide a professionally produced map showing the community boundary in time for the public meeting of 29 th June, if he is provided with a hand drawn map by the morning of 25 th June.	C Cook
•	It was agreed that the boundary should include complete postcode areas so that nobody with the same postcode as a neighbour is excluded from the defined community.	
•	It was agreed that the postcode areas should be selected on the basis that for the majority of households in the postcode the forest is a significant part of their view. This will be based on Mia Scott's photographic study.	
•	It was therefore agreed that we should look to identify the postcodes that fall within or across the boundary drawn as a result of Mia's photographic study. If a postcode crosses	

	this line, the line should be extended to include all houses in the postcode.	
•	Steve Byford will ask Roddy Beaton to identify the postcodes and draw a boundary based on a copy of Mia's map.	S Byford
•	Andrew Leaver will deliver a hand drawn map to the Bell Ingram Inverness office on the morning of Thursday 25 th June.	A Leaver
•	Crispian Cook also offered to make a composite aerial photograph of the forest using the photographs provided by Andrew Franklyn of Eilean Aigas Estate, if the photographs are suitable for this purpose. Graeme Scott to pass these photographs to Crispian Cook.	G Scott

The meeting will be asked to ratify this boundary.	
•	The remainder of the meeting will be led by Bell Ingram. The purpose of this session will be to hear the views of the community.	
•	Five tables will be established, each themed with one of the 5 E's (Environment, Economy, Energy, Education and Enjoyment). Participants will be asked to choose a table and there will be 15 minutes facilitated discussion before moving on to another table.
